You should set your Acrobat Reader to 'view single pages' and either 'fit to screen', or 'view full screen' (hit the Esc key to return to the pdf window) for the best viewing experience.

You can navigate through this magazine in the traditional manner using the 'forward/back', 'left/right' arrow keys in Acrobat, or use the arrow keys on your keyboard. If you do not want to read each page in turn, but want to go direct to a contributor, story, feature, article or page, just click on the button beside its entry on the contents page.
